#### 04/05 Post facto Approval of GATE Coaching

As per the resolution (Given below) a letter was written to NPIU for direction (Copy attached). A mail was received from NPIU permitting the in house coaching by internal as well as external faculty (Copy attached). Based on this mail, hon'ble chairman issued an order (Copy attached) to start the in-house GATE training with post facto approval from BOG. Reply of seven point questionnaire was asked by NPIU through SPIU regarding the GATE Training from the undersigned, which has already been submitted (Copy attached).

Resolution: Based on the rate quoted during first round, Gate Academy was given order for Civil, Mechanical and Electrical branch whereas Engineers Academy was given for EC and IT and LT for GATE coaching on 05.09.18. But these firms have shown their inability to run the course since the order was not placed within 45 days from the last date of bid submission i.e. on or before 21 .08.18. Hence  $2_{nd}$ round of bidding was called on 12.09.18, and based on the lowest rate, Engineers Academy was selected for GATE coaching of all branches, but the variation in the rate between the first and second round is more than 67% (Rs.11,139/- per candidate), hence BOG decided not to place the order to this firm. BOG agrees to place the order if the variation is within 15%, hence authorized to Principal to seek direction from NPIU stating all the facts. BOG also requested to SPIU to apprise NPIU about the discussion in the upcoming meeting of MHRD scheduled on 15 $_{
m th}$  Oct., 2018. It was also decided to request to the NPIU that newly appointed teacher based on Gate qualification should be asked to take the special gate class and should be paid honorarium or some expert if ages may be called for extra Gate classes. The honorarium can be paid as per NPIU norms.
