Team formation Rules [according to SIH 2019] & Instructions for Google Form submission: -

- There must be 6 members in a team, including Team Leader and minimum one girl member.
- Each team must have a unique team name.
- No team member can be in two different teams i.e. a team must have unique members only.
- All members must have a valid Email ID and Working Phone Number.
- All members must be from the same institute, but they can be from any department and any semester.
- The team must agree for not to be a member of any other team.
- The team must decide the domain of work i.e. SIH 2020 – Theme(s). [[Check website for detail](#)]
